TUESDAYS FOR TOTS ●●

Best suited for children ages 2 to 5.

Every Tuesday at 9:30 am and 1:30 pm enjoy this fun and educational time for our littlest visitors! Experiment together with art, science, language and math early learning activities that support early childhood learning. Children can practice important skills like taking turns and making friends as they explore the different stations that promote school readiness, social connections, and skill development.

STORY TIME ●●

Best suited for children ages 2 to 5.

Each Thursday at 9:30 am and 1:30 pm, we'll read a different book allowing your child to create real world connections as they familiarize themselves with the alphabet, new vocabulary words, and rhymes.

ART ADVENTURES ●●●●

Best suited for children ages 2 and up.

This is a creative space where children and their families can make art together. Each Thursday at 9:30 am and 1:30 pm, the Museum offers a multi-sensory craft that encourages self-expression and experimentation with different art mediums.

SCIENCE EXPLORERS ●●●

Best suited for children ages 5 and up.

On Fridays at 9:30 am and 1:30 pm, discover the many ways science is all around us in a program that is designed to spark curiosity and create those surprising "a-ha" moments for children that can last a lifetime. Whether children are experimenting with smells, designing an air powered car, or experimenting with color and dyes, these multi-sensory activities foster curiosity, creativity, and problem-solving skills.

STEAM SATURDAYS ●●

Best suited for children ages 4 and up.

Engage your little builder with a weekly STEAM challenge on Saturdays at 9:30 am and 1:30 pm! This is a hands-on exploration into the world of engineering designed to get children thinking. From building towers to working with gears and levers, children will see how their world works and make connections all their own.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS ●●

Sensory Sunday, February 4th from 10-12 will be Sensory Sunday. Sensory Sunday is a time where we turn off our sirens and flashing lights. We also have weighted vests and noise muffling headphones available upon request.
