

The River Farm America Grant

The River Farm America Grant was created to increase accessibility of field trips to the Children's Museum at Saratoga. Title I schools are encouraged to apply!

How do I apply?

To make the process as streamlined as possible, there is no application required for The River Farm America Grant. Trip coordinators from Title I schools may fill out a request form on the Museum's website. In the "Additional Questions/Concerns" section of the form, please note that you are interested in the River Farm America Field Trip Grant. We will email you back and, should you be approved for the grant, you will receive a Grant Recipient letter.

What are the Requirements of the River Farm America Grant?

In return for receiving the grant, we ask for a letter detailing the importance of a trip to the Children's Museum at Saratoga and why your school needs funding to make the field trip possible. We also ask for photos from the field trip, although we understand that this is limited to organization photo policy.

Grant Policies

- Organizations must be a Title I school or have a non-profit status to qualify.
- One group/grade level per organization may use the River Farm America Grant in each cycle.
- The River Farm America Grant may only be used to cover the cost of the field trip.
- The River Farm America Grant is a limited fund and will be awarded on a first-come basis at the Children's Museum at Saratoga's discretion.
