Children's Museum at Saratoga unveils "Fab Lab" exhibit bringing semiconductor manufacturing to life

GlobalFoundries supporting new museum exhibit with \$250K gift

SARATOGA SPRINGS, N.Y., May 20, 2026 — The [Children's Museum at Saratoga](#) (CMAS) announced its newest interactive exhibit, Fab Lab, an immersive, hands-on experience that introduces visitors to semiconductor manufacturing, made possible through partnership and support from GlobalFoundries (Nasdaq: GFS) (GF).
